

DIRECTIONS FOR **NO SEW /** **SINGLE (1) LAYER** **FLEECE BLANKET**

STEP 1

Remove selvages along both edges. This is the factory edge that is thin, curled over and sometimes white. There are two!

Please remove both selvages. They are ugly and your blanket will look better if you remove.

BONUS; You can use the leftover selvages to braid and make dog toys.

Blanket Materials Needed:

-Fleece Fabric (only 1 layer)

Baby: 1 yard of fabric

Child: 1 1/2 yards of fabric

Teen: 2 yards of fabric

-Scissors (for each person helping)

-Rotary Cutter

-Cutting Mat

-Ruler / 4" square corner tracers

Optional: masking tape, chalk

Baby 36"x36"; Child 40"x60"; Teen 45"x72"

ALL blanket sizes welcome but blankets NEED to be Clean, Flat and FREE of Pet Hair, Perfume & Smoke.

STEP 2

Cut a 4" square from each corner.

NOTE: Measure the first corner and then use that corner to measure the other 3.

STEP 3

Cut fringe 1" wide 4" deep on all 4 sides.

NOTE: Use your thumb as a gauge for the 1" width.
